Description: Experience a basic hands-on 2-day, 14-hour turning class designed specifically for the new woodturner needing basic instruction. Experienced woodturners from our club will instruct and support participants in learning how to turn six different projects:

| 2nd | Turn a Platter |
| 3rd | Turn a Bowl |
| 4th | Turn a small Goblet |
| 5th | Learn to turn Finials |
| 6th | Turn a Lidded box with a finial |

Different mounting options for the lathe will be taught (Between centers, screw drives, spur drives, chucks, face plates and other methods).

Tool sharpening instructions will be provided.

Each participant will be provided a lathe, all necessary lathe accessories, and all wood needed to turn the six pieces over the 2-day class.
